MINUTES

- I. Call to Order. Supervisor Sweeney called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- II. Roll Call. Present: Trustees Satern, Niewiardowski, Ingraffia, Keenley and Supervisor Sweeney. In attendance: Administrator Pioch, Assessor Carosielli, and Highway Commissioner Niewiardowski.
- III. Public Comment. None
- IV. Consent Agenda. Supervisor Sweeney asked for a motion to approve the authorization of payroll and bills and to approve the Supervisor's report consisting of information regarding General Assistance, Employment Support, Food Pantry, Transportation Services and Financials. A motion to approve was made by Trustee Niewiardowski and seconded by Trustee Ingraffia. *The motion passed on a 5-0 roll call vote.*
- V. Discussion and Approval of Minutes. Supervisor Sweeney asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the March 22, 2021 Regular Board Meeting. A motion to approve was made by Trustee Niewiardowski and seconded by Trustee Keenley. *The motion passed on a voice vote.*
- VI. Presentations. None
- VII. Elected Official Reports.
 - A. Assessor's Report. Assessor Carosielli submitted a written report. She also reported that the new county permit input system which allows Township offices to directly input information into the county data base has not been working properly. The system appears to have multiple deficiencies. She warned that these issues could lead to problems with the correct computation of Equalized Assessed Values (EVA).
 - B. Clerk's Report. Clerk Busse submitted a written report. He also reported that the previous Tuesday was the last day that mail in ballots could be received for the April 6th consolidated election. Based on the final vote results, the following individuals have been elected to Township positions: Supervisor – George Busse; Clerk – Suellen Satern; Assessor – Connie Carosielli; and Trustees – Dale Niewiardowski, Dick Keenley, Greg Wojtecki and Vince Dante. He announced that there will be a Special Meeting on May 17 at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Hall to swear in the newly elected officials.

C. Highway Commissioner's Report. Highway Commissioner Niewiardowski noted that this was his last meeting due to the elimination of the Road & Bridge Department through referendum in the fall 2020 general election. The services his department provided will be overseen by the Board and largely outsourced going forward. He thanked the residents of Elk Grove Township for the privilege of being able to serve them as their Highway Commissioner for the last 8 years.

D. Supervisor's Report. Supervisor Sweeney also noted that this was his last Township meeting. He will be moving out of State in mid-summer and did not run for reelection. He thanked the Board and the staff for their support during his eight years as Supervisor and expressed his pride in the success they had achieved as a team in consolidating and upgrading Township facilities and in expanding and improving Township services. He wished the best to the new Board and thanked the Township residents for the honor they afforded him by allowing him to serve as Township Clerk and Supervisor over the last 16 years.

E. Trustee Comment. Trustee Ingraffia asked for permission to thank the elected officials and staff for their support over the five and a half years that he served as a Trustee. He noted that it was a hard decision to not run for re-election and stated that he was sad to be leaving such a great organization. He stated that it had been an honor to serve as a Township trustee and thanked the residents for giving him the opportunity.
