A Message from the Supervisor...

I hope you are enjoying your summer. It's nice to have a modest reprieve from Covid 19. That said, we are not out of the woods and I encourage all of you to continue to follow the recommended health guidelines so that we can finally defeat the virus and put it behind us. Your new Township Board has been hard at work adding needed services and improving the services we are already providing Township residents. With the move to an updated, more cost-efficient Township facility largely behind us, we have been able to refocus our attention on

addressing the issues that improve the lives of residents and, most importantly, provide help to those in need. Recently the Township expanded the hours of its Food Pantry to include evening

hours. Every Tuesday the pantry is staying open until 7:00 p.m. in order to provide better access for those who find it difficult to visit the pantry during the day. If there proves to be significant demand for the evening hours, the Board will consider adding additional nights. The Township will soon be hosting a Veterans Service Office (VSO) which will aid veterans in applying for federal and state benefits and provide information on resources related to compensation, pensions and healthcare. As a veteran myself, I know how valuable this assistance can be. The Township is also in the process of building new, improved bike safety and youth challenge courses. The old courses were heavily used by the youth of our community for many years (I used the bike safety course so it might be for centuries). We look forward to being able to open the courses later this fall or next spring. These are just a few of the service improvements and additions the Township is putting in place. There are more to come, and they are all coming without an increase in your taxes!

Have a happy and healthy fall. Thank you for allowing us to be able to serve you.

Assessing the Situation

As of this writing, we await the results from the appeals filed with the Cook County Assessor. Once those results are published, we will anticipate the opening of the appeal period with the Cook County Board of Review. That 30 day window to appeal has yet to be determined. will However, attempt to keep you informed through our website, email and phone

Important: Please check your second installment tax bill to make sure that your exemptions have been properly applied. Due to errors at the Cook County Assessor's Office, many exemptions have been dropped. If you find that you are among them, please come in and we will attempt to correct the error.

The procedures to file with the Board of Review will remain the same as last year. If you are familiar with the online appeal process, my office will be more than happy to send you comparable properties via email, and you can file an appeal on your own by going to the Cook County Board of Review website, www.cookcountyboardofreview.com.

If you would prefer, you may call us at (224-265-6110) and we will assist you over the phone with your appeal. You may also use our dedicated email address, www.appeals@elkgrovetownship.com to ask for assistance with filing.

Lastly, please feel free to come into our office at 600 Landmeier Rd., Elk Grove Village. For your convenience, please call first and make an appointment. This will eliminate prolonged waiting periods, although appointments are not required.

We strongly encourage calling or emailing us first. If we are unable to answer your phone call, please leave a voicemail and we will return your call as soon as we possibly can.

We have installed hand sanitizer stations and protective barriers at our counters and desks to help ensure the health and safety of both my staff and the public.

We would like to remind you that during the appeals period we will be extraordinarily busy, and we ask for your patience and understanding. Please keep in mind that there will most likely be waiting time, whether it be in person or waiting for us to return your phone call or email, but rest assured, we will respond to you in an efficient manner.

I want to inform you of the passport services that the township offers as a Passport Acceptance Facility. I hope you find the following information helpful. ΑII of our passport services are bν appointment only, M - F, 10 AM - 3 PM. 847-437-0300 call Please an appointment. We have Passport Agents who speak English, Spanish, or Polish.

New Passports and Passport Replacement

Replacement passports are to replace lost or stolen passports or passports that have expired more than 5 years ago.

Items Needed for New Passports and Replacement Passports

- Proof of Citizenship birth certificate or naturalization certificate.
- Photo ID driver's license, state ID or previous passport.
- Passport Photo recent photo, within 6 months

NOTE: the township does not take passport photos - you need to do that before your appointment and bring it with you. Most stores with a photo department offer passport photo service.

 Form of Payment - check or money order only; cost of standard passport: \$110

Please call the township at 847-437-0300 for details on passport costs and fees.

Note: Minors under the age of 16 do not need an ID, but they need to have both parents present at the appointment (or provide a divorce or death certificate).

Minors age 16 - 17 can get an adult passport, need a photo ID which can be their school ID, and need one parent present at the appointment. Young adults age 18 and up can apply for a passport on their own.

Passport Renewals

If your passport expired within 5 years of the issue date, you can apply for a renewal. NOTE: you do not need to make an appointment and come in to the township office for a renewal. You can mail the renewal form directly to the U.S. Department of State.

If you are planning a trip where you need a passport, please plan far in advance in getting your passport application completed. Depending on the time of year, passports can take a lot more time to be received than at other times



LIHEAP IS NOW OPEN!

From September 1, 2021 - May 31, or until funds are exhausted, income eligible residents can apply for LIHEAP (Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program).

This program assists residential households with their gas and electric bills by paying an amount to the utility company through a Direct Vendor Payment (DVP) or by placing households in a subsidized budget bill via the LIHEAP-PIPP Program (Percentage of Income Payment Plan).



ComEd's Residental Special Hardship is available to income qualifying households who have experienced an economic hardship within the last 6 months. This program helps qualifying households reduce their outstanding balance by up to \$500. ComEd Residental Special Hardship is available from January 1st to December 31st or until funds are exhausted.

SALVATION ARMY SERVICE EXTENSION

Elk Grove Township is a proud Salvation Army Service Extension Site. We are able to assist clients who have had an economic hardship in the last 6 months with up to \$600 Salvation Army grants for their shelter and utility costs. Contact us for more information.

Youth Services

Hello parents,

In this newsletter, I wanted to take the opportunity to check in with you as a parent.

As a mother of three, I watch first-hand the everchanging world that we as parents must navigate. We do our best to support our children with school, friends, sports, and other social situations. It seems like this past 18 months all of our youth have struggled with so many challenges. As adults, we know we will get through and utilize a lifetime of skills to navigate and push forward. Unfortunately, our children do not have the same amount of experience in their lives.

To help us understand our kid's perspective, a year of a 10-year-old's life is 1/10th of their life! We remember that growing up and going to school was difficult enough without Online learning, hybrid learning, vaccines, and physical distancing in school classrooms.



As we design our programs each season, we keep the current needs of youth in mind...

- Does your child need help to manage stress or anxiety especially dealing with this "new normal?"
- Does your child's voice need to be heard with peers?
- Does your child struggle in high school with all of the responsibilities placed on them?
- Could your child (and the whole family) benefit from slowing down and just taking a breath?

Adult and Family Counseling

Does My Child Have ADHD?

Does my child have ADHD? This question is often asked by many parents, as they hear reports of their child not paying



attention in school or find them not listening at home, and they wonder if this is just normal or something else. The best way to start this conversation to understand what ADHD is. Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder

(ADHD) is a neurodevelopmental disorder that can affect a child's success at school, as well as their relationships. ADHD can also impact a child's self-esteem because it's more difficult for them to stay focused which may cause them to feel incompetent or "dumb". The symptoms of ADHD often vary from child to child even if they are siblings. Younger children may show more symptoms of hyperactivity than older children (who may be more impulsive). As a parent who has raised 2 children diagnosed with ADHD I know this can be difficult. But with a lot of patience and treatment, children can learn to adapt and become competent and successful adults.

Here are some common signs of ADHD in children:

- Self-focused behavior. This looks like an inability to recognize other people's needs and desires, which include interrupting when others are talking, trouble with waiting their turn and even butting into conversations or games they're not part of.
- Emotional turmoil. Children may have trouble with keeping their emotions in check. They may have outbursts of anger at inappropriate times. Younger child may have temper tantrums.
- 3. **Fidgeting**. Children with ADHD often can't sit still. They may try to get up and run around, fidget, or squirm in their chair when it's required to sit (often seen in school). It may also be difficult for them to play quietly or engage calmly in activities.

- 4. **Unfinished tasks.** Children may be interested in lots of things, but they may have problems finishing them. For example, they may start projects, chores, or homework, not finish, and move on to another thing.
- 5. Lack of focus. Children may have trouble paying attention even when someone is speaking directly to them. They may say that they heard you but won't be able to repeat back what was said. This can also cause a child to avoid activities that require constant mental effort, such as paying attention in class or doing homework.
- Mistakes. Kids may have trouble following instructions which can lead to careless mistakes; but it doesn't mean their lazy or lacking intelligence. In fact, many ADHD kids are very bright.
- 7. **Daydreaming**. A child with ADHD may stare into space, daydream and ignore what's going on around them.
- 8. **Trouble with organization**. An ADHD child may have trouble keeping track of tasks and activities which can cause problems at school with prioritizing homework, school projects, etc. A child's desk or locker maybe extremely messing where finding things is impossible.
- Forgetfulness. Kids with ADHD may forget to do daily activities. They may forget to do chores or their homework. They may also lose things often, such as toys.



To find out if your child has ADHD, call the Adult & Family Counseling Department for an ADHD screen at 847-981-0373.

Elk Grove Township Sewer Bill

Sewer billing does not pertain to all Township residents, but if you are served by the EGT sewer system and receive a Sewer Bill from the township, here is some information that you might find helpful.

The Sewer Bill is mailed out quarterly and is due on the last day of March, June, September and December. It can be paid:

- In person, at the Township Office, during our regular operation hours of 9am – 4pm Monday through Friday.
- By phone, by calling 847-437-0300.
- By mail, please send checks or money orders only (no cash) the Township Office, 600 Landmeier Rd, Elk Grove Village.
 - By using our after-hours deposit box located at the East Entrance (by the flag poles) of the Township Office.

Sewer Bills can also be paid in advance for the whole year. If you have any questions or concerns call us at 847-437-0300.



Senior & Disabled Transportation

Elk Grove Township Transportation department can offer a solution to get you to doctor appointments or the grocery store. You can use our services exclusively, or just when you need to. We offer curb-to-curb service to senior citizens (over 55) and disabled residents (over 18).



Township Buses

Township buses can take you to your favorite local places to do your shopping and to the pharmacy, fitness center, as well as to your doctor, dentist, optometrist or dialysis appointments. All rides within the township borders are FREE (free-will offering) and you can take one round trip ride each day Monday-Friday, as buses are available. In addition to curb-to-curb services, we also offer occasional bus trips and the TRIP program that will take residents to medical appointments outside our township boundaries.

DISCOUNT *TAXI*DEBIT CARD



The Township also offers a discounted taxi program for an additional form of transportation. The program provides a \$5 coupon per ride for riders traveling within Cook County using 303 Taxi. If you are a current registered rider please call the township to receive your new card. If you are not registered with this program, call to take advantage of this service.
