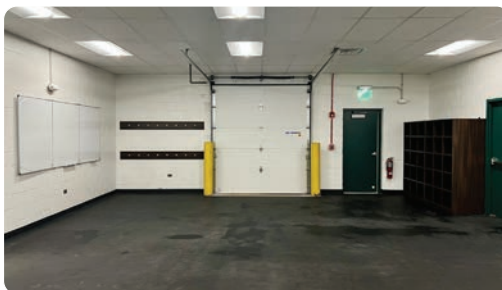


A MESSAGE FROM TOWNSHIP SUPERVISOR GEORGE K. BUSSE

Hello Township neighbors, I hope this newsletter finds you well and ready to enjoy your spring and summer. The stretch of days with subzero temperatures in January was brutal and I'm glad they are well behind us!

The Need Continues to Grow. The Township has had a busy start to the year. The need for the services we provide continues to grow exponentially and we have been working hard to meet the demand. The end of COVID assistance programs, inflation, and a growing incidence of mental health issues appear to be fueling much of the increase and, unfortunately, there are no signs of demand slowing. Since 2019 the General Financial Assistance we provide is up 225% and Emergency Financial Assistance is up 100%. Our Food Pantry is now serving close to 1,000 families a month and our Adult and Family Counseling team is looking to hire an additional therapist to deal with a growing backlog of clients. The rides provided by our Senior/Disabled Transportation services are back to pre-COVID levels and continue to increase. The need in these and other areas is great, and we are grateful for any support you can provide us in terms of donations or volunteer hours. We also encourage you to support the other valuable service organizations in our community such as WINGS, PADs, Kenneth Young Center, and Salvation Army. These are our partners in lifting our neighbors in need and they deserve your helping hand.

Good News! I'm excited to report that this spring should bring the completion of construction and the opening of the Youth Programs Challenge Course as well as a new Community Room. Elk Grove Township's Youth Services Department has served local youth for over 50 years and they continue to provide support to local schools. With our own Community Room, group facilitation and scheduling is easier and allows staff the flexibility to provide additional services. Be on the look out for an Open House coming this Fall!

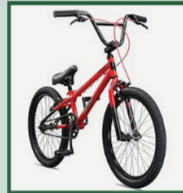

Let's try to look ahead to what's important for you this spring.

Exemptions

Those of you that qualified for the

Senior Freeze last year should have received your renewal notices by now. If you need assistance with filing this renewal, please call my office for help.

Remember, the homeowners and senior exemptions rollover each year.

First time applications for all exemptions are now being taken.

Appeals

We will be open two times during the year for appeals, once to the County Assessor, and once for the Board of Review.

The dates have not been released as to when you may appeal. If you would like to be notified by email or phone, please contact us at [224-265-6110](tel:224-265-6110) to enroll in our personal notification program.

When you are notified, call our office with your name, PIN or address, email, and phone number. We will be happy to research your appeal and file it for you. PLEASE, ONLY CALL THE OFFICE ONE TIME. MY STAFF WILL GET BACK TO YOU AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. MULTIPLE CALLS LENGTHEN THE TIME FOR US TO RESPOND.

Periodically check the township website, www.elkgrovetownship.com, for current information. We post information from the Assessor's office, Board of Review, and the Treasurer's office.

If, at any time, you have questions, we are available to assist you.

I want to inform you of the passport services that the township offers as a Passport Acceptance Facility. And I want to share the details of our new

service. **We now offer passport photos for \$10 a person.**

This can save you a stop and you can complete all the steps to apply for your passport at the township.

All of our passport services are by appointment only, M – F, 10 a.m. – 3 p.m. Please call [847-437-0300](tel:847-437-0300) for an appointment. We have Passport Agents who speak, English, Spanish, or Polish.

New Passports and Replacement Passports

Replacement passports are to replace lost or stolen passports or passports that have expired more than 5 years ago.

Items Needed for New Passports and Replacement Passports

- Proof of Citizenship – birth certificate or naturalization certificate
- Photo ID – driver's license, state ID or previous passport
- Passport Photo – recent photo within last 6 months
- Passport Forms – prefilled for appointment



- Form of Payment – check or money order only for U.S. Department of State fees; cost of standard adult (16 years old+) passport: \$130. Additional fees may apply.

Please check travel.state.gov or call the township for current passport costs and fees.

Note: Minors under the age of 16 do not need an ID, but they need to have both parents present at the appointment (or additional paperwork may be required).

Minors aged 16-17 can apply for an adult passport and are required to provide photo ID (can be a school ID or state issued ID). They may also need one parent or legal guardian present at the appointment. Young adults aged 18 and up can apply for a passport on their own.

Passport Renewals

If your passport expired within 5 years of the issue date, you can apply for a renewal. NOTE: you do not need to come into the township office for a renewal. You can mail the renewal form directly to the U.S. Department of State. However, you can get renewal forms and you can get a passport photo taken at the township, even if you are just doing a renewal.

If you are planning a trip where you need a passport, please plan far in advance in getting your application completed. Depending on the time of year, passports can take a lot more time to be received than at other times. The current processing time from the US Department of State for standard service is 6-9 weeks with expedited services offered for an additional \$60. Visit travel.state.gov for current passport and travel information.



SOCIAL SERVICES

SUPPORTING RESIDENTS THROUGH THE YEAR

Elk Grove Township offers a variety of social service programs to assist residents in need. Here's a glimpse at some resources available:

Back To School Blast Off: Looking ahead to the new school year, Elk Grove Township is again holding the Back to School Blast Off School Supply Drive from June 17th to July 31st. This initiative collects essential school supplies for children in need within the community. Donations of backpacks, notebooks, pencils, and other supplies can make a big difference for students starting the year off on the right foot.

These are just a few examples of Elk Grove Township's commitment to supporting residents. For more information on these programs or others offered by the township, visit our website at elkgrovetownship.com or call 224-265-6111.

LIHEAP: The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) helps qualified residents with their heating and cooling costs. LIHEAP can provide crucial assistance during the harsh winter and summer months, ensuring residents have a safe and comfortable home environment. Qualifying households must have income at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level in the 30 days prior to application. This year's program will end in August or until funds are exhausted. At this time, funds have been exhausted for the furnace program but keep an eye out on our website for furnace program updates.

As the price of utilities varies household to household, we know it can cause a burden to keep up with payments. If you find yourself struggling to pay your Nicor Gas bill please reach out to the Township. Our team can screen you for numerous programs that can assist with those costs.

FOOD PANTRY

WELCOME FOOD PANTRY SHOPPERS!

Food Pantry clients are encouraged to schedule appointments for monthly usage to meet their

household needs. The Pantry offers a wide variety of dry goods as well as household items, dairy and meat products, fresh produce, and personal essential items. Those with households comprising of four (4) or more members are eligible to utilize the pantry twice per month, ensuring an adequate supply of food and household essentials. To schedule an appointment, please call [224-265-6111](tel:224-265-6111). All that is required is a photo ID and recent utility bill (within the last 30 days). If it's your initial visit to the Pantry, please arrive 15 min before your appointment to receive your Food Pantry card.

Unable to physically make it to the Food Pantry? Our pantry offers a delivery service that you can schedule! Deliveries are only made on Mondays, and you can call [224-265-6102](tel:224-265-6102) to set up a delivery.

Please note: deliveries are restricted to elderly and those with disabilities. Clients must call the week prior to the Monday they would like their delivery.

AITCOY- Sponsored Training on Combatting Substance Use & Overdose

On February 22nd Elk Grove Township hosted an AITCOY sponsored training entitled Combatting Substance Use and Overdose through Awareness, NARCAN, Treatment Accessibility.



AITCOY (Association for Illinois Township Committees on Youth) is a state-wide organization promoting improved state-wide services for youth, technical assistance, networking, educational programs to enhance those professionals and family service programs serving youth.

As an AITCOY member, Elk Grove Township Adult and Family Counseling Program coordinated the training given by Daryl Pass, Recovery Support Service Manager from The Kenneth Young Center, and The Elk Grove Village CARES program. Attendees included counselors and non-professionals alike who are dedicated to preventing and assisting young people and their families from the potential lethal dangers of substance use.

Karina Balderas a Licensed Clinical Social worker and is also a Parent Educator. Karina works part time for the township and offers therapy in both English and Spanish.

Priya Bhatt, the newest member of the team has 7 years of experience, a Master's of Science in Health Psychology and a Master of Arts in general Psychology. Priya provides counseling services in English and is also fluent in Hindi and Gujarati.

Services are of no cost to residents, are provided either in English or Spanish, and more recently Hindi and Gujarati, in office or by telehealth with evening availability by appointment only. SERVICES FOR SENIORS

Elk Grove Township offers a variety of programs to help residents stay healthy and independent.

Medical Lending Closet: One valuable resource is the Medical Lending Closet. This program provides durable medical equipment, such as walkers, wheelchairs, and canes, to residents at no cost. The lending closet helps seniors maintain their mobility and continue living safely in their own homes.

Benefit Access Program: Another program is the Benefit Access Program. Income qualifying residents age 65 and older or disabled may qualify for a fee reduction towards their license plate registration. Call our department to see if you qualify.

Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP): Provides free counseling and education on Medicare options. A SHIP counselor can help you understand the different Medicare parts (A, B, D) and choose the plan that best meets your needs. Although open enrollment is only from October 15-December 7, you may qualify for special open enrollment if you are aging onto Medicare.

Paint-A-Thon: Is your home in need of a fresh coat of paint? You may be eligible to have it painted! Qualifying residents must be 60+ years old, veterans, or have a physical disability, and a household income of less than \$45,000. To see if you are eligible and to apply, please contact our Older Adult Programming & Benefits Specialist at [224-222-0942](tel:224-222-0942). The deadline to apply is Monday, July 1.

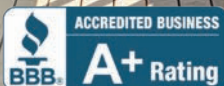

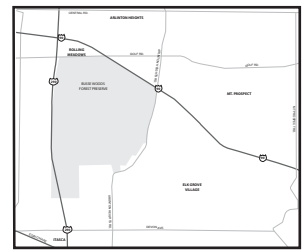
