SUPERVISOR'S MESSAGE CONTINUED...

Last year our client-choice food pantry handled over 12,000 family visits and our social services department provided temporary financial assistance in excess of \$120,000 to struggling residents. The Assessors office assisted taxpayers with submitting almost 3,500 appeals, exemptions and corrections. We added a new Senior Benefits Specialist, two new mental health therapists and psychiatric services, an additional senior transportation bus and software routing system, an online employment job board, a Veteran's Service Office and a new Community Services Office for passports and various licenses. Also, our Youth Services team opened the long-awaited bike safety and challenge courses and are working with our local elementary schools to teach social skills, suicide prevention and newcomer integration classes.

Without the support of a great team of elected officials and a hardworking, professional staff none of this would have been possible. Even more important, it was all accomplished with compassion and respect and with fiscal responsibility. The Township's share of the County property tax bill continues to remain under 1%. There is truly a lot for the Township to be proud of!

As I plan to leave office, I want to say thank you to the elected officials, the staff, the volunteers and all the other residents for all they have done, and are doing, to make Elk Grove Township such a wonderful community to live in. I have truly enjoyed serving the residents of Elk Grove Township and hope I have succeeded in leaving it a little better than when I started. I wish my successor, John Scaletta, and the new Township Administrator, Izabela Manzo, all the best as they settle into their new roles. I'm sure they will find, as I did, that they have some of the best jobs one could ever hope for.

ASSESSING THE SITUATION

Welcome to Spring! You have already paid your first installment property tax bill. The second installment bill will be arriving July 1st, due and payable August 1st. It

is on that bill you will see your exemptions reflected.

This year we will experience the triennial reassessment. You will receive your reassessment notice from the Cook County Assessor, Fritz Kaegi. It will show you the new value his staff

has put on your home. We do not, yet, know when this will happen, however, be assured, that we are here to assist you in researching and filing your appeals. We will also have two outreach programs, one with the Assessor's office, and at least one with the Board of Review.

Please keep in mind that the increase you see from the triennial will not appear on your second installment tax bill. You will see it on the second installment tax bill next year, 2026.

One of the most rewarding parts of my Clerk position is being the Chairman of the Mental Health and Wellness Committee. The committee reviews applications

from social service and mental health agencies that serve our residents in the township, and meets with representatives from many of the agencies. Then we determine the amount that we can grant to them to use in their programs for our residents. It is exciting to hear how each organization has helped our residents in the past year, and how they continue to improve and expand their services. The committee members include our Social Services Director and our Clinical Director of Counseling, one Township Trustee, and three township residents.

This year we granted \$620,000 to 29 agencies, a 3% increase over last year. Some of the agencies we support include Wings, Little City, Salvation Army, Kenneth Young Center, Shelter and Clearbrook. Some agencies provide assistance to the disabled, and seniors and youth, while others provide assistance with mental health services, housing, healthcare and more. When residents come to the Social Services Departments of the Township seeking assistance, we not only offer services such as General and Emergency Assistance, and the Food Pantry and other assistance if needed, but our staff can also connect them with agencies that specialize in their specific area of need. It is a win-win situation that avoids duplication of services.

Our Social Services to our residents have increased 200% from 2019-2024.

I am so grateful for our Board of Trustees, our Township leadership, and our employees and the many social services agencies that have a passion for helping our residents in need and improving their quality of life.

SMILE BRIGHTER WITH HELP FROM THE MOBILE DENTAL CLINIC!

Do you or your family need dental care but are facing financial barriers? Elk Grove Township, in

partnership with neighboring townships and Endeavor Health, is proud to offer access to comprehensive dental services through the Mobile Dental Clinic!

This incredible resource provides a "dental home" for community members who might otherwise go without care. The Mobile Dental Clinic offers complete dental care for the entire family, from routine checkups to more specialized treatments.

Who is eligible?

Residents of Elk Grove, Palatine, Schaumburg, and Wheeling Townships are eligible if they meet one of the following criteria:

- Income at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty
 Level
- Recipient of General Assistance
- Recipient of Medicaid

What are the fees?

- Children's services are FREE!
- Adult visits may have a \$40 co-pay.

How do I make an appointment?

The process is simple:

- 1. **Get screened:** First, you'll need to be financially screened by Elk Grove Township. This ensures you meet the eligibility requirements. Contact the Township at **224-265-6111** for an eligibility appointment.
- 2. **Schedule your appointment:** Once you've been approved, the Township will provide you with the phone number for the Mobile Dental Clinic so you can schedule your appointment directly.

Elk Grove Township Offers Lifeline to Residents Facing Unexpected Emergencies

Elk Grove Township offers Emergency Assistance to residents facing unforeseen and unavoidable crises that have caused them to fall behind on shelter or utility payments. This assistance is designed for immediate needs and requires a 5-day notice or utility disconnection notice for the current month's bill; future payments are not covered. Applicants must demonstrate proof of an unexpected emergency and proof of sustainability moving forward. A Case Manager will work with each applicant to determine the specific documentation needed for their individual circumstances.

Eligibility for Emergency Assistance is determined based on income guidelines. Applicants must submit documentation of all income received within the past 30 days, as the program adheres to the 200% Federal Income Poverty Line. Furthermore, all applicants are required to apply for all other available benefits, including Unemployment, TANF, SNAP, Social Security Income Benefits, Medicaid/Medicare, and LIHEAP. This ensures that all other avenues of support are explored.

Elk Grove Township is committed to supporting residents during times of crisis. The Emergency Assistance program provides a vital safety net for those experiencing unexpected hardships. Residents are encouraged to contact the Township for more information regarding eligibility requirements and the application process.

Employment Support Center

Elk Grove Township's Employment Support Center serves as a vital resource hub for residents seeking employment opportunities and career advancement. We offer a range of free services designed to empower job seekers, including resume and cover letter writing assistance, interview skills training, and access to online job boards and local employer connections.

Beyond individual support, the Employment Support Center also plays a crucial role in connecting local businesses with qualified candidates. By fostering relationships with employers and understanding their hiring needs, the center facilitates a mutually beneficial match between job seekers and businesses looking to grow their teams. WELCOME FOOD PANTRY SHOPPERS!

The Elk Grove Township Food Pantry successfully served over 12,000 families

in 2024 and aims to help all who are in need in our community. Food Pantry clients are encouraged to schedule appointments for their monthly visits to ensure their household needs are met. The Pantry provides a diverse selection of dry goods, household essentials, dairy and meat products, fresh produce, and personal care items. Households with four (4) or more members are eligible to visit twice per month for additional support. To schedule an appointment, please call **224-265-6111**. First-time visitors should arrive 15 minutes early to receive their Food Pantry card.

Unable to physically make it to the Food Pantry? Our pantry offers a delivery service that you can schedule! Deliveries are only made on Mondays, and you can call **224-265-6102** to set up a delivery.

Please note: deliveries are restricted to elderly and those with disabilities. Clients <u>must</u> call the week prior to the Monday they would like their delivery.

LOOKING TO APPLY FOR MEDICARE? MAKE AN APPOINTMENT WITH ELK GROVE TOWNSHIP!

Navigating the complexities of Medicare and health insurance

can be daunting for seniors. Elk Grove Township recognizes this challenge and provides valuable assistance through its Senior Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) counseling program. SHIP counselors are certified volunteers trained to provide free, unbiased information and guidance to Medicare beneficiaries. They can help seniors understand their Medicare options, compare plans, and make informed decisions about their healthcare coverage. This invaluable service empowers seniors to confidently manage their health insurance needs and access the best possible care.

One of the most significant benefits of working with a SHIP counselor at Elk Grove Township is the potential to enroll in Medicare outside of the traditional open enrollment periods. While general enrollment periods exist, certain special circumstances, such as losing other health coverage, may qualify individuals for a Special Enrollment Period (SEP). SHIP counselors can help seniors determine if they qualify for an SEP and guide them through the enrollment process. This allows seniors to access crucial healthcare coverage when they need it most, without being restricted by standard enrollment timelines. Contact 224-222-0942 to schedule.
