Around this time last year, we celebrated the successful launch of programming for our Bicycle Safety and Challenge Course, which

equips youth with the knowledge and skills to navigate their communities safely on two wheels. Through interactive presentations and hands-on demonstrations, participants gain confidence and learn to make safe, informed decisions while riding. The Challenge Course offers a lowropes course and teambuilding initiatives that help youth explore their strengths, work collaboratively, and overcome obstacles, building confidence, cooperation, and essential life skills.

Together, these programs reflect the mission of the Township's Youth Services Department, which supports young people during formative and often challenging years. Through educational programming, group work, and community outreach, Youth Services focuses on prevention by building confidence, strengthening problemsolving abilities, improving social skills, and helping youth develop healthy coping strategies, positive relationships, and overall mental health and wellness.

In the last fiscal year alone, our Youth Services staff provided 4,455 youth participants with access to these programs, a 65% increase over the previous year. Our youth represent the future of our community, and the Youth Services Department excels in building a strong foundation for emotional wellness and longterm success.

On this 4th of July, as our nation marks the 250th anniversary of its founding, we are reminded of the extraordinary journey that brought us here. This milestone is more than a celebration of history. It is an opportunity to reflect on the freedoms we cherish, the responsibilities we share, and the enduring promise of America. May this anniversary inspire us to come together, strengthen our communities, and continue building a future worthy of the ideals that shaped our nation.

Elk Grove Township is proud to serve as a Passport Acceptance Facility, processing approximately 800-900 passport applications each year. If you are planning to apply

for a passport, we encourage you to call **847-437-0300** to schedule an appointment. Our passport agents are available to assist residents in English, Spanish, and Polish, making the application process as convenient as possible. We also offer on-site passport photos, where applicants can obtain passport-compliant photos for just \$10. Whether you're planning a vacation, studying abroad, or preparing for future travel, Elk Grove Township is here to help. Here's important information to guide you through the passport application process.

Items needed for new and replacement passports:

- Passport Forms – filled out for appointment
- Proof of Citizenship – birth certificate, naturalization certificate or prior US Passport (expired is acceptable)
- Photo Identification – Driver's License, or State ID with one additional form of identification
- Passport Photo – available at the Township for \$10 fee (photo must be within last 6 months)
- Payment – check or money order only for US Department of State fees. Additional fees may apply. For more information on current passport costs and fees please call Elk Grove Township at **847-437-0300** or check travel.state.gov.

Note: Replacement Passports are needed to replace lost or stolen passports, adult passports that expired more than 5 years ago, or expired minor 5-year passports.

Passports for Minors:

- Under 16 years old - They do not need an ID, but both parents need to be at the passport appointment (or Consent Form 3053 or provide a death or divorce certificate).
- 16 – 17 years old - They can apply for an adult passport. They need one parent at their passport appointment, and a photo ID which can be their school ID.
- 18 years old – They can apply for an adult passport on their own.

Renewal Passports for Adults:

Passports that have been expired for five years or less may generally be renewed, provided all other renewal requirements are met. Please note, you don't need to come to the Township for a Renewal. The Renewal Form must be mailed to the U.S. Department of State.

The Township can help you with your Passport Renewal:

- Renewal Forms available
- Passport Photos for \$10.00
- Instructions for mailing your Renewal Application

Remember to plan ahead if you need a passport for an upcoming trip. The current processing time for applications is 4-6 weeks plus mailing time. Expedited services are offered for an additional \$60.00. The current processing time for expedited services is currently 2-3 weeks.

Passport Services are available Monday–Friday, 9:00 AM–3:00 PM. We recommend making an appointment, but walk-ins are accepted. For appointments and questions please call **847-437-0300**.

Summer is the perfect time to focus on your family's health and wellness and Elk Grove Township is here to help. Through a partnership with neighboring townships and Endeavor Health, eligible residents can access affordable, high-quality dental care through the Mobile Dental Clinic.

This valuable community resource provides comprehensive dental services for children and adults who may otherwise face barriers to care. From routine cleanings and exams to additional dental treatments, the Mobile Dental Clinic helps families maintain healthy smiles all year long.

Who Can Apply?

Residents of Elk Grove, Palatine, Schaumburg, and Wheeling Townships may qualify if they:

- Have a household income at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level
- Receive General Assistance
- Receive Medicaid benefits

Program Costs

- Dental services for children are provided FREE of charge
- Adult appointments may require a \$40 co-pay

How to Get Started

Getting connected is easy:

1. Contact Elk Grove Township at **224-265-6111** to schedule an eligibility screening.
2. Once approved, Township staff will provide the information needed to schedule directly with the Mobile Dental Clinic.

From learning safe biking habits to building friendships and social-emotional skills, the Youth

Services Department of Elk Grove Township is proud to offer a variety of enriching opportunities for local youth this summer and fall. These programs are designed to support children and teens as they grow socially, emotionally, and academically in a safe and welcoming environment. Through hands-on learning, peer connection, and skill-building activities, Youth Services continues its commitment to strengthening young people and families across the community.

Ride Safe: Bike Safety Program

The Bike Safety Program helps youth build confidence and develop safe riding habits through hands-on instruction and practice. Participants learn proper helmet fitting, hand

signals, rules of the road, street sign recognition, and basic bike-handling skills in a fun, interactive environment that encourages active outdoor play.

ADULT & FAMILY COUNSELING

MENTAL HEALTH MATTERS FOR OLDER ADULTS

Mental health wellness is important at every stage of life, however often overlooked

in older adults. Oftentimes well-meaning medical professionals dismiss the warning signs at a normal part of aging. However, common challenges in seniors can include:

- Depression – linked to loneliness, illness, grief and loss, and reduced mobility
- Anxiety – worries about health, finances, and major life changes
- Cognitive changes – memory loss, difficulty making decisions, reduced ability to problem solve, plan, and organize
- Complicated grief and difficulty adjusting to life transitions

Older adults living alone are more susceptible to having limited social contact, feeling lonely, and are at higher risk of emotional distress.

Family members, friends, and caregivers may notice warning signs to watch for including:

- Withdrawal and declining interest in activities or social events
- Changes in sleep or appetite
- Persistent sadness or irritability
- Increased confusion or forgetfulness
- Expressions of hopelessness or not caring about living
- Reliance on alcohol and other substances to cope

With support and treatment, older adults and seniors can access the support needed to thrive, not just survive. Counseling, medication help, support groups, and community programs are available and can be life changing.

It is vital to start with a conversation with the primary care physician and openly discuss the warning signs of mental health issues. After ruling out medical factors, a referral can be made to a Licensed Therapist who has experience counseling older adults. Private insurance, Medicare, Medicaid, and community-based program cover the costs for assessment and treatment of mental health care. Many times, information from and involvement of family members can make all the difference in supporting positive outcomes.

The Adult and Family Counseling Program of Elk Grove Township provides mental health therapy services to those of all ages including older adults and seniors. Township residents can access services for no charge and Licensed therapists also work with family members and caregivers and are knowledgeable about community resources. Services are available in person and by tele-health. The program is structured in such a way as to provide barrier free counseling services and provide holistic informed care.

SENIOR SERVICES

MEDICARE HELP IS AVAILABLE YEAR-ROUND THROUGH ELK GROVE TOWNSHIP

Many residents believe they can only make changes to their Medicare coverage during

the annual Medicare Open Enrollment Period each fall. However, certain life changes and special circumstances may qualify individuals for a Special Enrollment Period, allowing them to enroll in or adjust their coverage outside of the standard enrollment window.

Elk Grove Township's SHIP (Senior Health Insurance Program) Counselor is available year-round to help residents understand their Medicare options and determine whether they qualify for a Special Enrollment Period.

Situations that may allow for enrollment changes outside of Open Enrollment can include:

- Turning 65 and becoming newly eligible for Medicare
- Retirement or loss of employer health coverage
- Moving to a new service area
- Qualifying for Medicaid or Extra Help

- Changes in current insurance coverage
- Enrollment in certain assistance programs

Navigating Medicare can often feel confusing, especially during times of transition. The Township's SHIP Counselor provides free, unbiased assistance to help residents compare plans, understand benefits, review prescription coverage, and make informed healthcare decisions.

Residents do not need to wait until the fall Open Enrollment Period to seek guidance. If you or a loved one are experiencing a life change or have questions about Medicare eligibility and coverage options, Elk Grove Township encourages you to contact the Township at **224-265-6111** to schedule an appointment with the SHIP Counselor.

The SHIP Program is designed to ensure residents have access to trusted information and personalized support when making important healthcare decisions.

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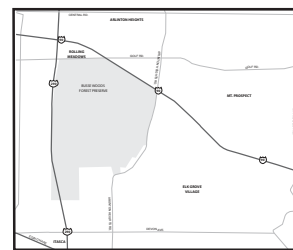

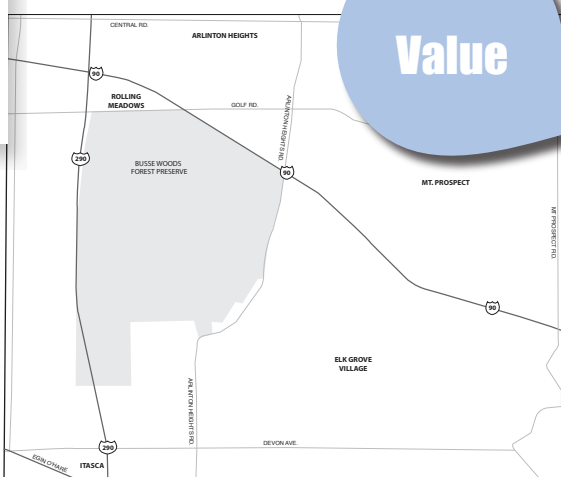
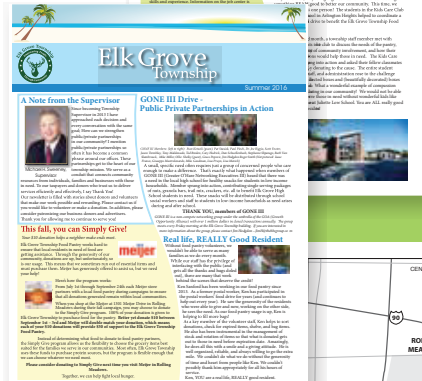
